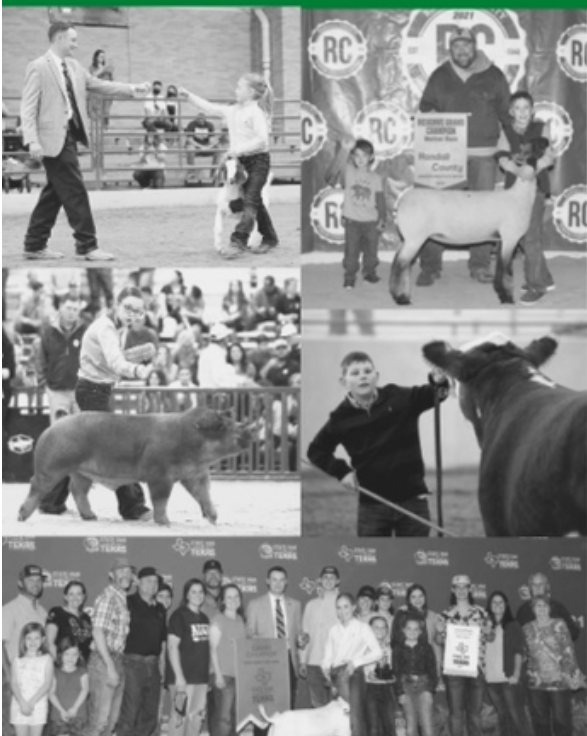
Meeting Location

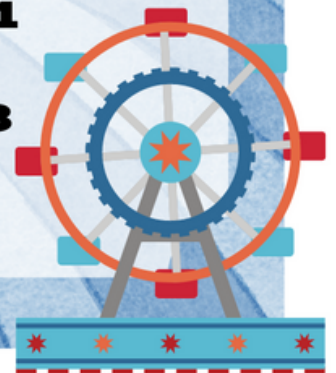
