#### HOW TO PREPARE NOW!!

- Complete your FAFSA at http://www.fafsa.gov/! It is REQUIRED to apply for all Texas 4–H Foundation Opportunity Scholarships (Baccalaureate, Technical, and Courageous Heart scholarships). Complete this before mid–December. If you wait, you may not have time to get the FAFSA paperwork submitted and receive the SAR report before the deadline.
- Request transcript from High School Counselor. Ask now to avoid delays.
- Gather all information from your 4–H experience. This is where record books come in handy; however, don't be discouraged if you didn't keep one. Apply anyway!
- The application process is lengthy, so it's important that you start the process ASAP.
